GlueFilm is the easy, no-mess adhesive for acrylic!

Supplies:

- (1) 12" x 12" sheet of Streuter GlueFilm™
- Scrapbook papers, ribbons and rub-ons, *Fiskars*
- Chipboard scrolls and trees, *Maya Road*
- Chipboard alphabet
- Metal alphabets
- Scallop Acrylic Album, *Clear Scraps*
- Staz-on ink pad in Timber Brown, *Tsukineko*
- Adirondack Acrylic Paint Dabber in Mushroom, *Ranger Industries*
- Various acrylic stamps
- Craft Iron
- Craft Knife
- Heat Gun

Instructions:

1. Cut various sizes of scrapbook papers and adhere them to the album using the GlueFilm and a craft iron. Trim around the edges where needed with a craft knife. Use the same method to cover the chipboard tree.
2. Use the craft iron and GlueFilm to iron the photos right onto the album page! It's so easy!
3. Use smaller pieces of GlueFilm and the heat gun to adhere the chipboard tree, scroll, and metal alphabets to the page.
4. Stamp the swirls onto the cover using the Staz-on inkpad.
5. Paint the edges of one of the pages with the Mushroom acrylic paint and let dry
6. Tie assorted ribbons to the album rings.
